



Homeowners: Did You Know?

Homeowners In Washington..

If you plan to dig or excavate on your own property more than 12 inches deep, you are required by law to notify owners of underground utilities **two business days** beforehand. Calling will ensure the underground gas lines and other utilities' lines are marked before you dig.

Homeowners In Oregon..

If you plan to dig or excavate on your own property more than 12 inches deep, you are required by law to notify owners of underground utilities **at least 48 hours** beforehand. Calling will ensure the underground gas lines and other utilities' lines are marked before you dig.

Contractors in Washington and Oregon..

Contractors must always call before beginning any excavation, no matter how deep.
