CASCADE NATURAL GAS CORPORATION

**PILOT RESIDENTIAL LOW-FLOW SHOWERHEAD PROGRAM**

**AVAILABILITY:**

This tariff implements a pilot showerhead program throughout the Bellingham and Mount Vernon, Washington service territory. The program is available to single- and multi-family residential customers who use gas as their primary water heating source. Customers currently using one or more low-flow showerheads are not eligible for the program.

**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

This tariff implements a residential low-flow showerhead program commencing July 1, 2008, for a period of two (2) months. The changes are proposed as a component of a Joint Utility Project between Puget Sound Energy, Tacoma Power & Water, Snohomish PUD, and Cascade. Through a third-party vendor, Cascade will deliver free low-flow showerhead(s) to qualifying gas water heat customers to reduce water heat energy requirements.

**DEFINITION:**

For purposes of this program, a low-flow showerhead is defined as a showerhead that delivers 2 GPM (gallons per minute) at 65 psi (pounds per square inch).

**IMPLEMENTATION:**

Cascade will inform all qualifying gas water heat customers of the showerhead offer. Upon customer request, Cascade will distribute a low-flow showerhead conservation package.

**GENERAL PROVISIONS**

The administrative and program delivery costs associated with this program will be accounted for and recovered through a temporary technical adjustment mechanism in the deferral tracking portion of the Company's annual PGA filing. Any terms savings realized from this pilot will not be included within Cascade Natural Gas Corporation's Conservation Plan targets for calendar year 2008 as approved through the Commission under Docket UG-060256.


