What is Energy Assistance or LIHEAP?

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program is a federally funded program for qualified households that provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs.

Essential Energy Assistance Facts

1. Contact your local Community Action Council to see if you qualify.
2. The financial eligibility requirement is 125 percent of federal poverty guidelines (see chart below).
3. Both homeowner and renter households are eligible.
4. There is a one-time benefit per year (program year Oct. 1-June 30).
5. Participants must re-apply each year (program year Oct. 1-June 30).

IMPORTANT

You must contact your local Community Action Agency to apply for energy assistance. See list of agencies on the back cover.
