UPGRADE NOW WITH INSTANT DISCOUNTS

Between the bath, kitchen and laundry room, hot water is always in demand, typically consuming 20 percent of the average home's energy bill. Upgrading to an energy-efficient water heater can reduce monthly energy expenses and help lower hot water costs. Qualifying high-efficiency gas tank water heaters are eligible for a \$100 instant discount at local retailers.
