- Change out dirty furnace filters.
- Pay attention to changes in temperature and smell in your home. Hot air interrupted by cool air through vents means your furnace is not performing the way it should. Contact a professional HVAC contractor if you detect chemical smells or reach out to Cascade Natural Gas if you smell a potential gas leak.
- Inspect and monitor the heat exchanger for soot and water.
