WHAT IS ENERGY ASSISTANCE OR LIHEAP?

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is a federally funded program for qualified households that provides a one-time benefit (per program year) to assist with heating costs.

Essential Energy Assistance Facts

- 1. Contact your local Community Action Council to see if you qualify.
- 2. The financial eligibility requirement must be at or below 60 percent of Oregon's median income (see chart below).

- 3. Both homeowner and renter households are eligible.
- 4. There is a one-time benefit per year (program year Oct. 1-June 30).
- 5. Participants must re-apply each year (program year Oct. 1-June 30).

IMPORTANT

You must contact your local Community Action Agency to apply for energy assistance. See the list of agencies on the back cover.
