WINDOW EFFICIENCY IS MEASURED IN U-VALUE

Energy Trust cash incentives for high-efficiency windows range from \$1.00-\$1.50 per square foot and are based on the U-value.

The U-value (or U-factor) measures how well a window insulates your home as rated by the National Fenestration Rating Council (NFRC).

The lower the U-value, the better insulated the windows are, and the more cash incentives you may receive from Energy Trust.

DIY TIPS

Follow these tips to increase comfort and savings:

- Seal cracks around windows and weather-strip doors and operable windows, to reduce the loss of heated or cooled air.
- Use shades and blinds to control direct sun through windows in both summer and winter to help heat or cool your space.
