METER TESTING**

METER TESTING EQUIPMENT

The Company uses a combination of the following equipment for testing new, rebuilt, and in-service meters:

- a. Sonic nozzle provers for proving meter sizes up to 1,000 cfh.
- b. Transfer provers for proving meter from sizes from 800 cfh through 220,000 cfh.
- c. Manometers or differential pressure recording device for differential pressure testing meters sizes from 800 cubic feet per hour through 102,000 cfh.
