RE: Cascade Natural Gas Conservation Program Adjustment Annual Filing

Cascade Natural Gas Corporation ("Cascade" or "Company") submits to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") the following revisions to its Tariff WN U-3, with a stated effective date for service on and after November 1, 2026:

Ninety-Second Revision Sheet No. 596

The purpose of this filing is to revise Schedule 596, Conservation Program Adjustment ("CPA") to collect ongoing conservation program expenditures.

The rates are a per therm charge, amortizing the outstanding deferral balance of \$35,463,408 plus interest for the twelve months ending July 31, 2026.

The \$35,463,408 is comprised of \$20,842,487 for the residential program, \$1,165,386 for the commercial program, \$2,138,039 for the low-income program, \$4,249,871 is for administration costs, and \$7,067,625 is for the residual balance from last year's filing. The total amortization requested in this filing is a debit of \$36,134,355. The annual revenue change reflected in this filing is an increase of \$14,801,256 to customers, or an increase in annual revenue of 4.16 percent.

Below is a table summarizing the proposed changes reflected in this filing:

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The impact to an average residential customer using 53 therms per month will be an increase of \$3.15 or 3.26 percent.

The proposed change will affect all of Cascade's retail sales customers. Cascade serves approximately 206,962 residential, 27,714 commercial, 516 industrial, and five interruptible customers in the state of Washington.

In compliance with WAC 480-90-194(3), the Company will mail customers a bill insert notifying them of the proposed rate increase. The issuance of bill inserts to customers will begin on September 15. In addition, Cascade will publish on its webpage the anticipated rate increase, provide copies of the notice to Community Action Agencies and organizations within its service territory, and provide notice to the news media. The Company will provide a copy of the bill insert in a separate filing, Advice No. W26-09-01.
